New Officers Were Installed



Transition in Leadership



The Surgical Outcomes Club is under new leadership. Karl Bilimoria, MD, MS, from Northwestern University began his two-year term as President in November. This term is renewable once. Dr. Bilimoria has served on the Board since 2011, and was elected Secretary in 2013.

Dr. Bilimoria is a surgical oncologist and a health services and quality improvement researcher at Northwestern University's Feinberg School of Medicine. He is also the Vice Chair for Quality in the Department of Surgery. His clinical practice is focused on melanoma, sarcoma, and breast cancer.



In addition, Amir Ghaferi, MD, MS, from the University of Michigan was elected by the Board of Directors to serve as Secretary. Dr. Ghaferi began his two-year term in November. This term is renewable once, and serves as President-elect. Dr. Ghaferi has been an active member since 2009, and has served on the Board since

2010. Dr. Ghaferi is a bariatric and minimally invasive surgeon and his research focuses on understanding the relationship of organizational dynamics to quality and efficiency, with the ultimate goal of designing interventions to improve care locally, regionally, and nationally.
